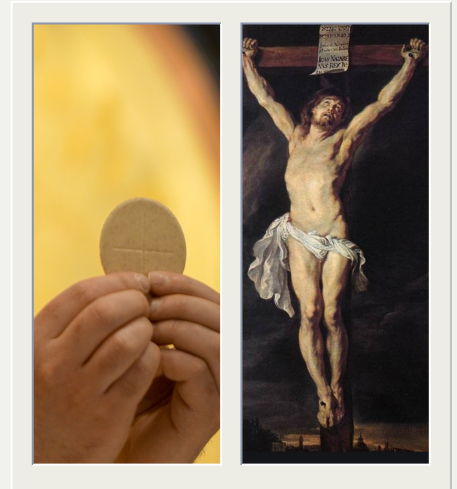

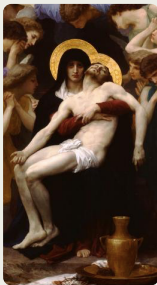
LESSON ONE

1. MASS – The Divine Call to Salvation.

- We are called to participate in the Divine Sacrifice of the life, death and resurrection of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
- The greatest act of love is sacrifice.
- God dying in the flesh and on the cross for all of us.
- This death is a call and an invitation to salvation.
- We cannot live without the sacraments.
- Eucharist is nourishment and food for our souls.
- The Eucharist gives everlasting life.



2. Attitudes at the Crucifixion of Christ, attitudes at Mass:



- What is your attitude during mass? Here are the 4 examples that were at the crucifixion of Christ. Which one are you?

- Roman soldiers**- Shows indifference. They crucified Jesus without knowing what they were doing.
- Thief crucified next to Jesus** – Receives the gift of eternal life because he recognized the Kingship of Jesus. The thief opened his heart to Jesus and asked for HIS forgiveness.
- Mary Magdalene**- Has repentance and understands that Christ through his death has forgiven her. She is not afraid or ashamed of her sins because she has laid them before Jesus.
- The Blessed Mother**- She brought love to her Son and consoled Him. She gave Him the love He deserved.
